To participate in the redevelopment and ongoing usage of the O'Connor House, an exceptional heritage property in an excellent location close to the Don Valley Parkway and Highway 401.



Opportunities are available to sponsor the preservation of a room (rooms) and grounds. The O'Connor Estate is entrusted to the Irish community to refurbish and use as a place of Irish culture, heritage and learning; business may become involved in its restoration; and creative use of personal talent and natural gifts in renovation work.



The property comprises approximately 10,000 s.f. in three buildings--House, Coach-house and Storehouse. These three buildings are arranged around a landscaped courtyard at the main entrance to the new Senator O'Connor College School. The uses of the O'Connor House must be compatible with those of Senator O'Connor College School.
